- Strengthen your leadership and professional skills and make new connections

Before being matched, candidates must participate in a a virtual Orientation, which will provide an overview of the board matching process, along with best practices and tips for serving on a board.

BoardBridge is for 501(c) nonprofit organizations who:

- Desire to expand their circle of potential board candidates
- Are looking to welcome new board members

Before being matched, each nonprofit must have a staff/board member participate in a virtual Orientation, which will provide an overview of the board matching process, along with best practices and tips for recruiting and onboarding new board members.
