Along the way, you'll hone your facilitation, negotiation, and communication skills, explore issues facing our region, and tap into resources to become a more effective leader.

Who Should Apply

Women In Leadership is open to women of all ages with a desire to strengthen their leadership skills and effectiveness. Ideal candidates include mid-level managers, entrepreneurs and community leaders.

Alumnae leave the program with a deeper understanding of themselves and their goals, along with the knowledge, skills, resources and networks to bring those goals to life. You'll also join the network of more than 11,000 FOCUS alumni.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Curriculum

Program days include a mix of speakers, interviews with regional leaders, small-group discussion, interactive exercises and reflection activities, led by FOCUS' experienced facilitators, subject-matter experts and regional leaders.

While program content is continually evolving to meet the needs of each class, the curriculum covers:

- Leveraging Your Strengths & Emotional Intelligence
- Personal Brand Management
- Negotiation Strategies
- Field Days - Exploring Leadership Across Sectors

Participants also complete a self-directed Personal Leadership Project.

Commitment

The Women In Leadership program consists of four seminars, and three Field Days, giving you the opportunity to immerse yourself in the region, explore different styles of leadership and talk with business, community and civic leaders.

Impact

In an evaluation of recent Women In Leadership graduates:

- 100% better understand their strengths and how to use them to achieve their professional goals.
- 100% felt they increased their ability to look at issues from multiple angles, seek out new perspectives, and take meaningful action.
- 100% broadened their network and developed meaningful relationships.
- 100% would recommend the program to others, and 94% felt better equipped to lead.

Application Process

Applications for the FOCUS Women In Leadership program can be found online at www.focus-stl.org. Two recommendations are required; a link to the form is available online.

The application deadline for our Spring 2027 class is Saturday, Nov. 7, 2026. Interviews will take place Saturday, Dec. 5, from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

You may also nominate an employee or colleague for the program online, and we will follow up to provide them with the application materials.

Tuition

The tuition for the Women In Leadership program is \$2,500, which includes a complimentary FOCUS St. Louis membership during your time in the program.

Tuition is often covered in part or full by the participant’s employer. Partial scholarship assistance is available to those with demonstrated financial need.
